



Source Control Technician- Temporary position up to 18 months

The Alberta Capital Region Wastewater Commission (ACRWC) is an ISO 14001 registered regional services commission providing wastewater transmission and treatment services to over 300,000 people in 13 municipalities surrounding the City of Edmonton. The ACRWC owns and operates 200 km of wastewater transmission lines, 5 pumping stations, and a modern state of the art wastewater treatment plant. Our mission is to provide responsible transmission and treatment for member municipalities. The ACRWC Treatment Facility is located near the North Saskatchewan River just north of Sherwood Park, AB.

General Responsibilities:

- Planning and conducting site inspections of, and sampling wastewater discharged from, regional industrial, commercial, and institutional (ICI) facilities and hauled wastewater septage receiving stations.
- Educating stakeholders about the Source Control Program's initiatives via municipal events, wastewater seminars and other forums.
- Management and analysis of data/records.
- Monitoring compliance to regional bylaws.
- Generating and issuing technical reports and correspondence to various internal and external stakeholders.
- Assessing wastewater discharge applications from member municipalities/ICIs and developing and managing corresponding wastewater discharge permits.
- Liaising with ACRWC member municipalities and ICI customers.

Qualifications:

- Environmental or related diploma or certificate OR previous source control experience OR valid wastewater treatment or collection certification.
- Intermediate experience with Microsoft Office (i.e. Excel and Word).
- Possession of a valid Alberta Class 5 Motor Vehicle Operator's License. A Driver Abstract may be required.

Assets:

- Knowledge of Sewer-Use Bylaws, Provincial and Federal guidelines and regulations.

The successful candidate must be well organized and have excellent computer, communication, interpersonal and decision-making skills. Candidates must be physically fit and willing to perform duties of the position in all types of weather including lifting up to 20kg.

There is opportunity for career growth for the successful candidate. This temporary full-time position will be up to 18 months.
